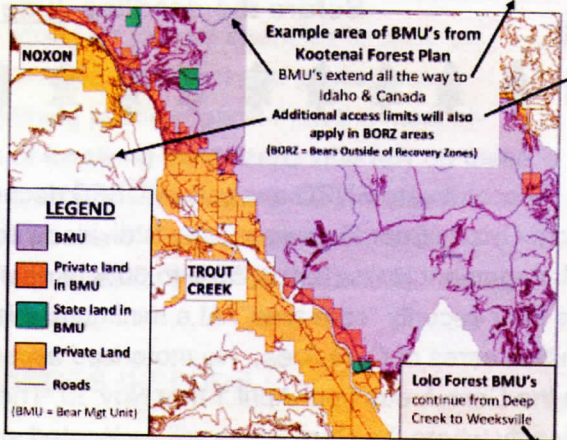

- 2.2 MILLION ACRES W/ACCESS RESTRICTIONS IN KOOTENAI, LOLO, & IPHNF
- ROADS & TRAILS CLOSED ON OVER 1.2 MILLION ACRES
- GRIZZLY BEAR POPULATION DENSITY GOAL HIGHER THAN YELLOWSTONE
- FEDERAL ZONING OF PRIVATE LAND WITHOUT NOTIFICATION OR CONSENT
- OBLITERATION OF UNKNOWN QUANTITY OF ROADS, TRAILS, CAMPGROUNDS
